Downs Junior Air Raid Shelter, Evacuee suitcase & Jive Party – Thurs 2nd and 9th November

The classes visit Downs Junior Air Raid Shelter where the children will be able to experience local WWII shelters. Please note the Jive Party date is to be confirmed. Cost £7.50.

Newhaven Fort – Wednesday 15th November

The classes visit Newhaven Fort for the day. The children will experience a simulated air raid in the Blitz bomb shelter, learn about the Home Front and explore the fort. Coach and admission costs £11.00.

The total cost for these trips and visit is £18.50.

This payment is voluntary, but without parental contributions we could not run these trips. Payment is made via ParentPay.

Please return the permission slip and payment (via ParentPay) to the school office by Monday 2nd October 2017. The permission slip will cover all trips, and pupils without permission will not be able to attend. Relevant medical conditions should be included and whether or not you allow permission for your child to be included in photos, which might be used by organisations for publicity or evaluation.
